Terms & Conditions

LHTD 2025 Information and Instructions for Steam Engines

- 1. The date of the event is 22nd June 2025. Arrival at Henry Street Car Park, Lymm, is open from the evening of the 20th June to the evening of the 21st June.
- 2. Acceptance and entry into the event are under the condition that you abide by these terms and conditions and follow direction from the event marshals on the day.
- 3. Participants will receive two free event passes.
- 4. The safety of the public is paramount and during the day of the event movement in and out of the car park should only be done with the permission of Chris Adamson, our Steam co-ordinator, and the guidance of at least one steward.
- 5. Participants must remove their own waste from the event.
- 6. It is vital that your engine is covered with Public Liability Insurance of at least £1m.
- 7. Please note that there is no gas or electricity provided by the event. If this is required, you must bring your own.
- 8. We will, however, provide water and coal for the engines.
- 9. Engines need to be fully insured for driving on the roads, with an up-to-date boiler certificate. Each engine's NTET disc information will be checked upon arrival.
- 10. Tables and chairs are not provided, you will need to bring your own.
- 11. Due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather, access issues or serious health and safety concerns, it may be necessary for the event organisers to cancel the event. This can occur at any time up to the time of the event's scheduled opening. If the Event is cancelled the Event Organisers will not be responsible for any financial, trading or other loss of whatever kind incurred by the exhibitor.
