## **Lymm Historic Transport Day**

## **INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS**

- 1. We open for setup from 8.00 a.m and to the public from 11a.m.
- 2. There will be **NO ACCESS** to the May Queen Field (MQF) after 10:15am.
- 3. The event finishes at 5pm.
- 4. There can be **NO VEHICLE MOVEMENT** on the field between 10:25am and 5pm. Entry into the event is given on the understanding that this rule will be followed.
- 5. Participants will receive two free event passes on arrival.
- 6. Traders are permitted one vehicle per plot (unless agreed by prior special arrangement).
- 7. ALL vehicle, stall, equipment, etc must be:

## ! KEPT WITHIN THE ALLOCATED PITCH!

- 8. NOTE. There is NO POWER OR WATER provided on the MQF.
- 9. Prohibited sales: tobacco, alcohol (except licensed bar) and any illegal substances.
- 10. For alcohol sales a TENs licence must be in place prior to the event.
- 11. Food hygiene certificates must not be more than 3 years old.
- 12. In accordance with the single use plastic ban October 2023 you must not supply single-use plastic plates, trays and bowls to members of the public.
- 13. Pre packaged food for direct sale must clearly display the ingredients with allergens in BOLD (Natasha's Law 2021)
- 14. As part of the application process for all traders and stall holders, insurance, hygiene and risk assessment documents will need to be submitted.
- 15. Risk Assessments must cover all items within your plot, including tables and any other structures.
- 16. Gazebos are permitted, but not with guy ropes. Instead they should be weighted / pegged at the corners. They must be taken down if the Health & Safety Officer declares it to be too windy for gazebos on the day.
- 17. Limited Saturday setup may be possible by prior special arrangement.
- 18. Participants must remove their own waste from the field and leave the plot in the same condition they found it.

- 19. Tables and chairs are not provided, you will need to bring your own.
- 20. All vehicles on display need to be insured for displaying at a static event. You will need to confirm that you have this insurance policy prior to your place being confirmed.
- 21. Vehicles should be legally roadworthy, with up-to-date road tax, insurance and MOT. If your vehicle is not legal for driving, then you must contact us directly for special arrangement to be made.
- 22. Applicants should fill in the appropriate form, we then aim to get back to applicants within four weeks of submission. We do not assign places on a first come basis, rather we aim to curate an eclectic and historic line up of cars that we think will interest a wide range of people. That said, places do fill up quickly, so getting your application in early does offer an advantage. People applying close to the time of the event are highly unlikely to be offered a place.
